The Protective Factors

The five protective factors enhanced by the participation in Parents As Teachers.

- ♥ **Parent Resilience:** The ability to cope and bounce back from challenges
- ♥ **Social Connections:** friends, family neighbors, or other members of the community who provide emotional support and concrete assistance to parents.
- ♥ **Knowledge of parenting and child development:** Accurate information about raising young children and appropriate expectations for their behavior
- ♥ **Concrete support in times of need:** Access to support like Medicaid, BCMH, and informal social networks
- ♥ **Children's Social and Emotional Development:** A child's ability to interact positively with others and communicate his or her emotions effectively.

What services does Parents As Teachers provide?

- Answers to questions about your infant and toddler's health and development
- Information about your infant or toddler's immunization, nutrition and expectations for developmental milestones and behavior
- Referrals to services that may be helpful to the child and/or family
- Opportunities for social networking with other families and their children
- Developmental, vision, hearing and nutritional screenings
- Age-appropriate activities for the children and families that promote the enhancement of age appropriate skills, development, and parenting skills.

- ♥ Women who are pregnant
- ♥ Caregivers of children birth to 5 years old
